Visa	Non-European students must submit a visa application before coming to France – Information is available here: https://france-visas.gouv.fr/web/france-visas/
Estimated budget	Average budget: around 600 ~ 700 euros/month for living expenses (food & single room accommodation...)
Health insurance (compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ For European students: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) ➤ For non-European students: Health care expenses can be reimbursed by the French Social Security system. Students must register here (free of charge): https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/ To be covered at least the first 2 months of their stay in France, we highly recommend students to purchase a private health insurance before leaving their home country. It takes some time to be registered by the French Social Security System.
Complementary insurance	For a higher reimbursement rate, it is highly recommended to take out an additional medical insurance (around 20€/month).
Civil liability (compulsory)	Civil liability and repatriation (around 20€/year)
